He has made regular representations at an international level as a contributor to, and organiser of, symposia and exhibitions in electronic and digital art. Recently exhibiting in China, Japan, Australia, New Zealand, Turkey, USA, Africa, France, Czech Republic, Poland, Germany, Austria and the UK, he is gaining international acclaim as a pioneer and leader in his field.

Keith Brown will be talking about his work and research as a contemporary artist using printmaking in relationship to his sculptural work.

The talk will take place on Wednesday 6.30 pm, 10th of February in Greenbank Lecture Theatre at University of Central Lancashire.
